Day 1 Home City ✈ Paris

Depart from home city for Paris, the capital of France.

Day 2 Paris (Louvre Museum) ~ Shopping / optional River Seine cruise

Arrive at Paris. The first stop is at Louvre Museum where the immortal painting of Mona Lisa, Winged Victory of Samothrace, Venus de Milo, the Great Sphinx of Tanis, etc. are housed. Afterwards, a shopping stop for around 2 hours at Lafayette or Printemps Department store is provided. Lastly, an optional cruise along the River Seine is highly recommended as another way to discover Paris.

Day 3 Paris (city tour) ~ Montmartre Hill ~ at leisure / optional Versailles Palace tour

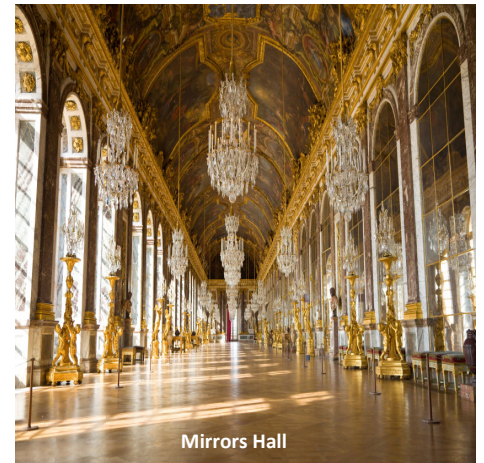

Day 5 Cologne ~ Zaanse Schans ~ Amsterdam (city tour) ~ Canal cruise

Drive to Zaanse Schans to visit the cheese and wooden shoes factories and to admire the outlook of the windmills in full display.
